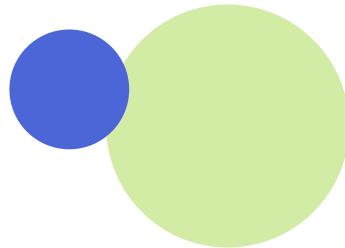




## How Many Ways Can You Take Turns?
